We offer **flexible schedules** for our staff and low student/instructor ratios. **All counselors must attend mandatory orientation training as a prerequisite condition of employment. Open positions and rates of pay as follows:**

- **Instructor rate of pay: \$22/hour**
- **Junior Counselors (16-17 years old) rate of pay: \$18/hour**

- Be able to work outdoors for at least 1 hour at a time
